

Activity Report Foundation Art Foundation Animas 2025 Policy Plan 2026

Introduction

The Objective of the Art Foundations Animas Foundation is the public exhibition of art collection in general and of Salvador Dali in particular.

The Spanish fishing village of Cadaqués in the province of Catalonia is associated with the artist Salvador Dali. The village and the landscape around it appear frequently in his oeuvre.

Many visitors come to sample the Dali atmosphere. However, there is no exhibition space where Salvador Dali's work is shown.

The foundation was given a 500m2 exhibition space where 300 graphic works from the private collection of Salvador Dali by Mr. H.S. de Jong and others were publicly accessible.

Activities 2025

The activities are organized in Expo Dali Cadaqués from April 15, 2024 to October 15, 2024 from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm throughout the week (7 days)

During this period, several thousand people visited the exhibition.

The average length of stay of visitors was 45 minutes.

Visitors' ratings are rated 4.5 out of 5 stars on social media (Google, Tripadvisor).

A project was initiated to make the presentation of the artworks more interactive with visitors. The rise of AI technology is making this possible.

The foundation sponsored a "Soundscape" project where sounds are generated to match the artworks on display.

Visitors are welcomed at the entrance lounge on demand by an AI-rendered voice of Salvador Dali in the languages Catalan, Spanish, French and English.

Policy 2026

ACADEMIA DALÍ

To organize additional cultural activities, we have converted a section of the museum that was previously closed to the public into a space suitable for hosting separate cultural events and exhibitions.

The following exhibitions will be held:

June 20 through July 14, "CODEX REM" by artist Daniel Zerbst.

July 17 through July 28: "TRANMONTANA" by artist Hans Mulleners.

August 1 through August 23: "EL DOLOR CANSAT D'UNA LLÀGRIMA SIMPLIFICADA" by Txell Miras

August 28 through September 13: "SOMIO PER TANT SOC" by artist Augustin Pineau

October 8 through October 11: INCADAQUÉS FESTIVAL featuring various artists.

The exhibition space is located at the rear of Expo Dali. The location is: Calle Curro s/n

The artists are provided with the space free of charge and do not have to pay a commission on the artworks they sell.
